





Prof. (Dr.) Dipika Deka made several visits to AllMS, Kalyani during her tenure from November 2018 to March 2019 to discuss the AllMS Kalyani project with the stakeholders and HSCC officials. She took the primary initiative to start the first MBBS batch by signing agreement with Director of Medical Education, Govt. of West Bengal and thereby starting temporary office & classroom in the College of Medicine & JNM Hospital, Kalyani.

Prof. (Dr.) Deka repatriated from AllMS, Kalyani on 08.03.2019.


#### ABOUT AIIMS, KALYANI



Land Area: 179.82 Acres, Total Project Cost: 1754 Crores Executing Agency: HSCC India Ltd.

The Union Cabinet approved the establishment of AIIMS, Kalyani on 07.10.2015 under Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana, Phase – IV with total project cost of 1754 Crores. The Central Government has established AIIMS, Kalyani in exercise of powers Conferred by the provision of Sub-section (1) of Section 3 of the AIIMS, Act, 1956 vide Notification dated 24th January, 2018 as published in "The Gazette of India".





AIIMS Kalyani came into existence through Gazette notification dated 24<sup>th</sup> January, 2019 of Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India.

The project is being implemented in following two Phases:-

**Phase I -** Construction of Residential complex and OPD Block including internal and external electrical, HVAC, PHE, Fire Fighting, external development etc. and their maintenance during defect liability period. **Contractor-**M/S KMV Projects Ltd.

**Phase II** – Construction of the Hospital and Academic campus including internal electrification, HVAC, PHE, Fire Fighting, external development etc. and their maintenance during defect liability period. **Contractor-** M/S Ahluwalia Contracts (India) Ltd.

Establishment of AIIMS, Kalyani: The Union Cabinet approved the establishment of AIIMS, Kalyani on 07.10.2015 under PMSSY, Phase – IV with total project cost of 1754 Crores in exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to sub-section (1) of Section 3 of the All India Institutes of Medical Sciences Act, 1956 (25 of 1956), the Central Government established All India Institute of Medical Sciences at Kalyani in the State of West Bengal vide Notification dated 24th January, 2018 of the MoH&FW, Govt. of India as published in the Gazette of India.

MoH&FW (PMSSY Division) notification of the Mentor Institute: MoH&FW, vide notification dated 5<sup>th</sup> November, 2018, nominated AIIMS, Bhubaneswar as Mentor Institute for AIIMS, Kalyani.

Nomination of the President of AllMS, Kalyani: In exercise of the power conferred by section 7 (1) of the All India Institute of Medical Sciences Act, 1956 (25 of 1956), the Central Government nominated Prof. (Dr.) Chitra Sarkar, Professor of Pathology, Dean (Research), AllMS, New Delhi as the President of All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Kalyani on 27th November, 2018.

**Joining of 1st Director, AllMS, Kalyani:** On 29.11.2018, Prof. (Dr.) Dipika Deka took charge as the 1<sup>st</sup> Director of AllMS, Kalyani.











Decision to establish a temporary campus at the College of Medicine & JNM Hospital (COMJNMH), Kalyani for starting the 1<sup>st</sup> batch of MBBS for the Academic Year 2019:



- (a) On 06<sup>th</sup> December, 2018, Prof. (Dr.) Dipika Deka visited the office of Director of Medical Education. The meeting was attended by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, WBUHS, Addl. Secretary, DHFW, Govt. of WB, Special Secretary, H&FW, Govt. of WB, Principal, College of Medicine & JNM Hospital COMJNMH, and MSVP (COMJNMH). The roadmap to start temporary office and classrooms for 1<sup>st</sup> MBBS programme at COMJNMH was laid down during the meeting.
- (b) Prof. (Dr.) Dipika Deka, Director, AllMS, Kalyani visited COMJNMH on 08.12.2018. During the visit Prof. (Dr.) Deka interacted with the Principal, COMJNMH. The other officials of COMJNMH present in the meeting were Dean Students' Affairs, MSVP, Dy. Superintendent and Associate Professor, Community Medicine.

**Advertisement for Faculty/SR/Tutor:** On 22.01.2019, AllMS, Bhubaneswar, being the Mentor Institute of AllMS, Kalyani published advertisement for Professor, Additional Professor, Associate Professor, Assistant Professor, Senior Resident & Tutor for total of 19 departments. Total 19 posts of Professor, 13 posts of Additional Professor, 15 posts of Associate Professor, 38 posts of Assistant Professor, 8 posts of SR and 8 posts of Tutors were published. Atotal of 101 posts were advertised.



- 3. We have conducted our audit in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in India. These standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatements. This does not include accrued interest of Rs.9.06 lakhon the savings account no. 491401001544 for the year 2018-19. This resulted in understatement of Income/Surplus by Rs.9.06 lakh as well as Corpus/Capital Fund to the same extent.

#### Net effect of Audit Comments on Accounts:

The net impact of audit comments given in the preceding paragraphs is understatement of Corpus/Capital Fund and Liabilities by Rs.9.06 lakh.

#### B. Grants-in-Aid

Out of grants in aid of Rs.27.29 crore received during the year, the Institute spent Rs.0.22 crore leaving a balance of Rs.27.07 crore as unspent at the end of the year.
